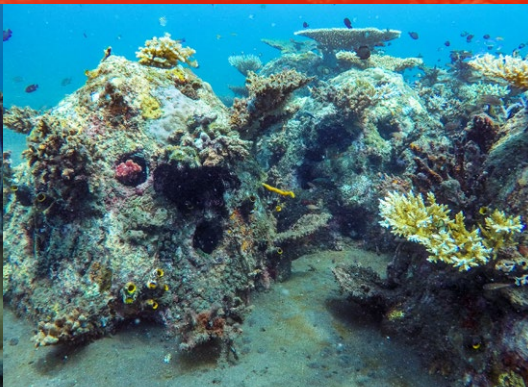

Before placing you on the Coral Heroes map, here are few things we need from you:

About your Organisation:

- Short biography of your organisation: When was it founded? Who is the team behind your organisation? How did you choose your specific location?
- Description of the social-economic and environmental situation of the location of the nursery. Don't hesitate to be specific about challenges and struggles you encounter or observe regarding the local situation, or about your own organisation.
- Are you working with/employing people from local communities around your location?

If you are already doing coral rehabilitation:

- When did you start coral rehabilitation? Have you encountered any difficulties?
- What kind of materials are you using to make the nurseries?
- Please describe your process of coral collecting, attaching and maintenance.
- GPS coordinates of the nurseries location.

If you are not yet doing coral rehabilitation:

- What method do you plan on using?
- Have you had previous experiences in coral rehabilitation?
- Do you need assistance from specialists to start a nursery?

To properly ensure all costs of the restoration activities are covered through adoption, please provide us with a precise estimate:

- What are the costs of your nursery set up (material, conception, installation) —> If you haven't yet started, you can make a close estimate.
- Cost of maintenance (staff, diving equipment...) (monthly/yearly)
- Taking part in the Coral Heroes program implies taking monthly pictures of each nursery and each individual coral. Can you estimate how many dives it will take, the cost of photographic equipment and dive gear? (monthly/yearly)
- In the future, the adoptions will allow you to involve and hire people from local communities to plant and maintain the corals. Can you estimate their wages (monthly/yearly?)
